

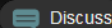
## Martin County cleanup slated for May 1

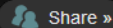

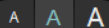

MARTIN COUNTY — Keep Martin Beautiful is coordinating a countywide cleanup from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. May 1.

Last year, more than 1,200 volunteers of all ages removed nearly 11,785 pounds of litter from streets, parks, beaches and waterways.

One of the current projects is a neighborhood cleanup of East Stuart. The first phase on March 13 set records for waste collection during a neighborhood cleanup in Stuart. The second phase, painting the 16 homes, will be April 17.

Volunteers are still needed for the painting and can register at the Gertrude Walden Children's Center in Stuart.

Other cleanups scheduled include Pettway Park in Hobe Sound on April 10, Halpatokee Park in Stuart on April 17, a Golden Gate neighborhood cleanup on April 24, and both Stuart Beach and Jensen Beach cleanups on May 1. All of these events will begin at 8 a.m.
